WHEREAS, from the very beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic, Bari Ramburg has played an integral role in tackling the complex problems facing the community; and

WHEREAS, as a registered nurse and stout advocate for community well being, Bari Ramburg has dedicated her time and expertise to the Covid-19 response; and

WHEREAS, Bari Ramburg worked with the Aspen School District to help organize, implement and administer Covid-19 tests at the school. This was a critical tool in order to keep students in school safely throughout the pandemic and control transmission rates throughout the entire community; and

WHEREAS, when Covid-19 vaccinations were approved, Bari again stepped up and joined the IMT and Public Health mass vaccination clinic as a volunteer vaccinator. Throughout the mass vaccination effort Bari helped administer over 20,000 doses over the course of 13 weeks; and

WHEREAS, during the transition towards a smaller and more dynamic vaccination clinic model, Bari helped Public Health pivot to meet the needs of the community by continuing to volunteer her time and expertise. Throughout the clinics, Bari has not only administered countless vaccines and tests, but also helped assuage community anxiety, encouraged hesitant individuals to receive a vaccine, and tirelessly brought her energy, expertise and compassion to the Covid-19 response.
