GOAL (for review 1/15):

Leverage the Land Use, Building and Energy Codes to ensure that all elements of the built environment—land use, transportation, housing, energy, and infrastructure— work together to provide places for living, working and recreating that reflect our community values.

- *Reduced energy and water consumption in buildings*
- *Improved energy efficiency in existing building stock*
