**PUBLIC NOTICE:**

Pitkin County, Colorado, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the County's intent to revise the flood hazard information, generally located within the County limits. Specifically, the flood hazard information shall be revised along the South Side Split Flow - Roaring Fork River in the split flow region south of State Highway 82.

As a result of the revision, the floodway shall be eliminated, the 1% annual chance water-surface elevations shall increase and decrease, and the 1% annual chance floodplain shall widen and narrow within the area of revision.
