How to Fill Sandbags

Fill sandbags 1/2 to 3/4 full, tie at top so bag will lay flat when put in place. Overfilled bags leave gaps in levee allowing water to seep through.

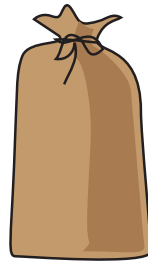
RIGHT FILL
